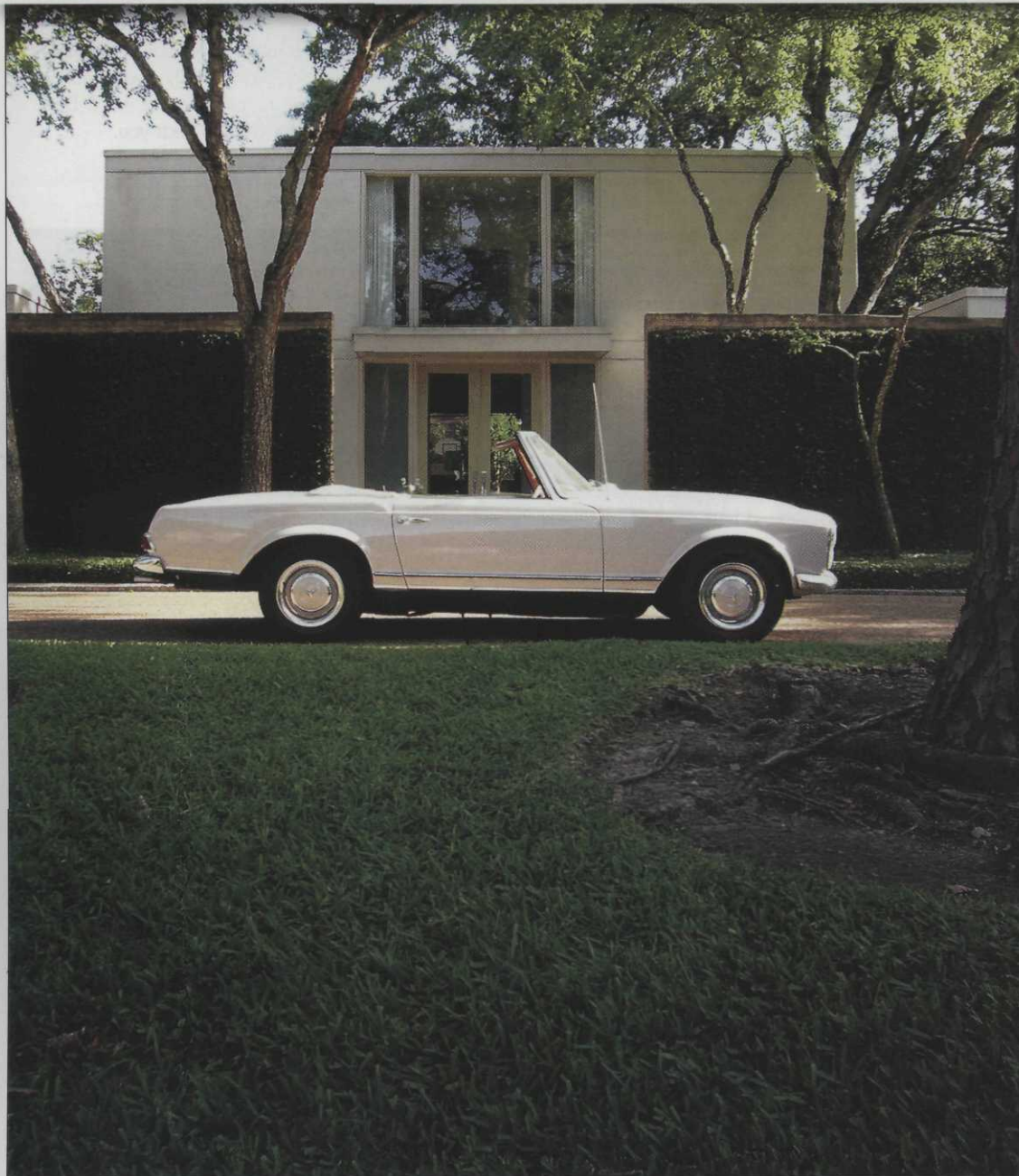


HOUSTON MOD | HUGO V. NEUHAUS JR.

Houston Mod opens its third architectural exhibition featuring the modern houses of Hugo V. Neuhau Jr. August 2 at the Architecture Center Houston Downtown.

NEUHAUS WAS A HOUSTON ARCHITECT WHO GRADUATED FROM THE HARVARD GRADUATE SCHOOL OF DESIGN WITH A BACHELOR OF ARCHITECTURE IN 1942 DURING WALTER GROPIUS'S TENURE AS DIRECTOR (1938-1952). At Harvard

Neuhau was a classmate of another locally known architect Philip Johnson. Although Neuhau worked on a wide range of building types during his career, he seemed to have a special fascination with the design of houses. Cowell & Neuhau worked with Philip Johnson as associate architects for the Menil House at 3363 San Felipe in 1948-1951.

Neuhau completed his own house at 2910 Lazy Lane in 1950. It is one of the finest Miesian houses in Texas, and in 2006 it was designated as one of Houston's first modern landmarks at the behest of its current owners, Michelle and Robert A. Mosbacher. On view thru
